Our Insurer has requested we have an agreement with each subcontractor for each job. Feeling this to be quite a cumbersome task for all, we have negotiated, and they will accept a single agreement that covers all job engagements.

If you are a new subcontractor with us we will need all the documents listed in the Subcontractor Agreement (see checklist below).

We recommend sending the list to your insurance agent and they will let you know if you are missing anything and they will also forward us the insurance documents we need.

## Here is a checklist:

- 1) \_Signed Federal Form W-9 (you fill out this form, you can get one online or we can provide one).
- 2) \_Certificates of Insurance (Provided on a Primary and Noncontributory basis and each including Waiver of Subrogation):
  - a) \_General Liability (\$1M occ/\$2M agg), Harbor Builders Associates as Additional Insured.
  - b) \_Commercial Auto Liability (if applicable), (\$1M comb single limit), Harbor Builders Associates as Additional Insured.
  - c) \_Workers Compensation, or for Independent Contractors a Predetermination of Contractor Status (Maine application form WCB-261). If you need help with the WCB-261 let us know.
- 3) \_Signed Subcontractor Agreement.
